MEETING

We will have a general membership meeting on July 8 at 7:30 PM at Travis County Precinct #2 Building at 13303 Low Water Crossing Road. This is off Hwy. 620, north side of Mansfield Dam, and on Lake Austin side of Road. We will have the results of our election of executive committee members for the next year.

SPEAKER

Our guest speaker will be John Scanlan. He is an ex-director of LCRA and will speak on what help we can expect in the future from the LCRA. This will be a "stem winder" type of speech with some real fire works. After this informative discussion, you will have some doubts about state bureaucracies.

HEARINGS

On June 9 and 10, a hearings examiner of the Texas Water Commission heard the permit renewal request of Kingsland MUD to continue discharging 750,000 gallons per day of effluent into Lake LBJ.

On May 28, a hearings examiner of the Texas Water Commission heard the request to increase discharges of effluent into Lake LBJ on existing permits of 2 LBJ MUD's. A continuance was granted so that some agreements on land application of effluent can be pursued.

NOTE: PLTA was at both of these hearings to offer evidence relating to the merits of land discharge.
